Tip 1: When kids have no manners? (Dialogue Script)

Docudrama 1: DON'Ts

Mother: Good Morning, Mrs Lee.

Expert Advice

Prof. Wong Po-choi: There are two ways to teach the kids. One is to teach him what to do beforehand. The other is to teach him after they have done wrong. If you teach them after they have made mistakes, it's certainly harder to make it because they are feeling bad and may be scared. So, parents should teach their kids what to do beforehand. When the kids have been psychologically prepared, they will behave properly. If parents know how to teach their kids, the kids will be good.

Mother: Siu-yee, do you remember what Mum has told you? What should you say when meeting people in the morning?

Siu-yee: Good morning!

Mother: Right. Sweetie! When you say good morning, you are wishing them a wonderful morning! Let's try. Good morning! Siu-yee.
