Tip 2: When kids make mistakes time and again? (Dialogue Script)

Docudrama 1: DON'Ts

Expert Advice

Prof. Wong Po-choi: When kids make mistakes again and again, naturally

parents will be unhappy and think that they're being naughty. Actually, adults also make mistakes time and again, not to speak of kids. Parents shouldn't overreact. It's quite normal for kids to repeat their mistakes. What we should do is to teach them to correct their mistakes. When there are problems, we have to steer our kids to think and see how we can take the opportunity to

enhance their thinking ability.

Docudrama 2: DOs

Mother: Siu-yee, where's your handbook?

Siu-yee: I left it at home.

Mother: Oh, you've forgotten to bring it along! Siu-yee, do you know why

you've forgotten to bring the handbook?

Siu-yee: I don't know. Maybe after finishing my homework last night, I left

it on the desk, forgetting to put it into the schoolbag.

Mother: What can you do to help yourself remember to put it into the

schoolbag?

Siu-yee: I don't know. Could you remind me next time, Mum?

Mother: I'm afraid I may forget too. Let's write down all the things you've

got to bring on a piece of paper to remind ourselves. Would this

help?

Siu-yee: Great! And stick the piece of paper to the back of the door too.



We could hardly forget then.

Mother: Brilliant! You know how to solve problems. But we don't have

Siu-yee: Go home and get it, of course.

Mother: Right. Let's go.
