Mr LAM (LAM) : (More money or more time?) More time

(Career or family?) Family (Wife or children?) Wife

(Are two children enough?) Yes (The most blissful moment?) Now

Mrs LAM (Christy) : (Should your husband spend time with you or with the children?)

With the children

(Helicopter parents or freestyle parents?) Freestyle (Play the good guy or the bad guy?) The bad guy

(Husband or children?) Children

(The thing you love most about your husband?) His ample body size

### An unforgettable experience of giving birth to the second child

Christy : The most unforgettable was

after giving birth to the baby I thought she couldn't be saved

because the condition was too extreme

a delivery too premature

LAM : During her second pregnancy

unfortunately, she was diagnosed with placenta accreta

There was no space for the (fetal) growth

because with the placenta imbedded in the uterus fetal development and growth were restrained

Placenta accreta often makes it impossible for the mother to keep her

uterus

because (the placenta) remains attached to it

Even after the baby is born

the placenta will still remain attached to the uterus

causing severe blood loss in the mother

The doctor forewarned us that the uterus would also be removed

At 26 weeks, the little girl couldn't wait to break away

We called an ambulance

My wife delivered the baby on the ambulance

and lost a lot of blood

(The ambulanceman) immediately wrapped such a tiny baby in a space

blanket

Her feet were this small

She knew not even how to breathe

and required a high dose of growth hormone injection

Could she survive?

No one could help her and she was on her own

### Premature birth and strong-willed struggle for recovery

Christy : I had a blood transfusion of 11 bags of blood

replacing all the blood in my body once

LAM : She regained consciousness after the extensive surgery

Christy : I asked, "How did it go? Can our baby girl make it?"

(The nurse said,) "I have no news about it"

"Is my uterus still fine?"

(The nurse said,) "It's gone"

"That's fine"

"Would you mind helping me ask about my baby girl's whereabouts?"

"I want to know"

"if she's alive or gone"

LAM : It was the next morning when my wife woke up and saw me

Only a 1-hour visiting session was allowed

The first thing she asked me was

Christy: "Where's our baby girl?" Where's our baby girl?"

"Is our daughter gone?"

LAM : It was fairly inconvenient to talk at that time

I said, "Our daughter's fine"

Christy : I felt a strong urge

to "strive for improvement"

I had to make an extremely speedy recovery as fast as I can

All for my baby girl

I had my immense inner strength unleashed there and then

Recover sooner! Recover sooner!

# Miraculous turnaround of daughter's condition

LAM : We saw our baby girl getting better over time

and a miracle unfolded gradually

The miracle happened

as we noticed our daughter overcoming obstacles one by one

and growing very rapidly in size

She stayed at the NICU (Neonatal Intensive Care Unit) for 77 days in

total

I remember that when 60-day old, she already weighed 5 pounds

Wow, how amazing!

Even the nurses at the hospital said she had a pretty huge reserve of

strength

I could slowly put my mind at rest only two months afterwards

## A new dimension to life having overcome adversity

LAM : Much simpler

I won't be wanting or insisting on many other stuff

That isn't necessary

Having the whole family together is already invaluable

This is also the hardest part

After Charmaine was born, I turned down all job offers

For a whole year, there was no work but my family to take care of

We witnessed her going through many follow-up medical appointments

Finally last time

(the doctor said,) "She really has nothing requiring special attention

and there's no need to come back (to the hospital)"

It was truly a weight off my mind

Then I resumed my work

### Close sibling relationship between the girl and her most caring and doting brother

LAM : Actually our son is very understanding

Christy : And very sensitive

LAM : He looked forward to his younger sister coming home as well

so when she was discharged he came along too

He was also very excited

to have someone he would call "younger sister" in the family

Christy : It's usual for parents with two children to say that

the elder often bullies the younger one

Our son has never done so really

He's really good

say, he would not disturb his sister's sleep

LAM : I think their bonding is predestined

It's impossible to force it however hard you try

To put a big smile on the girl's face and cheer her up

are something only he's able to do

Our home may have a lot of noise going on now

but in a warm and lively way It makes me miss home

## **Words from LAM to Christy**

LAM : It's good enough that she stays safe and healthy

There's nothing else worthy (to insist on)
Having suddenly found myself in bed alone

without the other half by my side

been through that feeling

I don't want to experience it ever again

It's good enough that you're all sleeping here

## **Words from Christy to LAM**

Christy : He's really exceptional in problem solving

His presence gives space for my brain to rest a bit

LAM : Not a bit

but many years

Christy : I can rest for a long time

Having the whole family around is a strong desire in me
